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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON FEEDBACK FOR THE SESSION 2021-22

The IQAC members take note on the issues that are reflected in the feedback report and resolves that the general demands for renovation in infrastructure will be considered with due importance. In this respect, the IQAC Coordinator mentions that some of the popular demands are already addressed by the College, for instance, the construction of the girls' hostel is complete. The Teacher-in-Charge is requested to expedite the formalities to make the ladies hostel functional by 2023-24 academic session. It is also resolved that the washrooms and the ladies common room will be renovated as early as possible. The Coordinator of the IQAC is requested to meet the Library Committee and to formulate a plan to simplify the book transaction procedure in the central library.

On the basis of the suggestion of the Committee for administering the feedback, it has been resolved that from the 2022-23 session students' feedback will be collected online through College website. The report on the feedback that will be collected from the outgoing/ end semester students will be subsequently analyzed by the committee. IQAC will contemplate on the report once it is available and implement requisite measures on the basis of the report.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON FEEDBACK FOR THE SESSION 2022-23

The Report clearly indicates the general satisfaction of the students regarding the academic and administrative ambience of the institution; however, a nominal percentage of the students also depicts their lack of satisfaction about adequate learning opportunities. It has been decided that the teachers will be communicated about this nominal discontent particularly about the teaching learning process and the same to the library and non-teaching staff regarding their respective zone of action. The analysis reflects that every aspect of the college has areas for improvement and the IQAC acknowledges its responsibility to augment the process of overall improvement.

- Students laid their demand, to improve the toilet facility for both Girls and Boys.
- A Gymnasium is another thing which students wanted to be augmented into their facility.
- A seminar room is another a long-standing demand from all corner be its students or teachers.
- In our students' feedback questionnaire, we didn't include questions about exploring any job opportunity from the college itself but students desperately expressed their willingness, if any such effort be initiated.

The IQAC makes a thorough scan of the feedback analysis of the teachers and found that observations are reflected in issues like syllabus, ICT facilities, the merit of the students, classrooms and laboratory facilities and above all, the academic discipline of the College. On the basis of the survey, the IQAC proposes for required infrastructural augmentation to enhance the facilities in the classrooms and the laboratories. The IQAC requests the Principal to take adequate steps in this regard. The IQAC requests the Principal to take adequate steps in this regard.

Significant improvements have taken place recently, based on feedback analysis from previous years:

1. Additional classrooms have been provided for every department.
2. A state-of-the-art seminar room has been constructed, addressing a long-standing demand from both students and teachers.



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3. The Boys' Common Room has been renovated.
4. The Girls' Common Room has been relocated and newly constructed to include enhanced facilities such as sanitary vending machines, which were previously absent.
5. A 24-set gymnasium has been added to our facilities, available to both male and female students.
6. Toilets for both boys and girls have been renovated and increased in number.
7. The drinking water facilities have been significantly improved.
8. The administrative office has undergone extensive renovations.
9. The number of ICT enabled classrooms is increased.
10. Lastly, the introduction of on-campus jobs for students marks a groundbreaking step towards generating employment for our college's graduates.

Moreover, the feedback received from parents indicates overall satisfaction across most metrics. However, a few parents expressed concerns regarding the information system. The IQAC has taken note of these concerns and, following their and teachers' suggestions, has implemented modifications to the website notices about exams and other matters. Additionally, it was decided to incorporate a more comprehensive notice display system, such as an LCD screen, within the college premises. The IQAC requests the Principal to take appropriate steps in this regard.
